The historic 1809 Meeting House on Orange Street is the island's premier location for destination weddings, with two venues from which to choose. Recently restored to its original nineteenth-century splendor, the large, light-filled Sanctuary accommodates 400 guests. The 1830 Goodrich organ and Steinway grand piano fill the hall with beautiful music. Hendrix Hall, our smaller chapel on the first floor, was renovated over the winter with new carpeting and cushions, and accommodates 150 guests.

We welcome couples of all religious backgrounds, interfaith and same-sex couples, as well as blended families. Our Minister works closely with the couple to create a one-of-a-kind ceremony that suits their religious orientation and aesthetic tastes. Our Director of Music is available to assist with the selection of music and guest musicians. Guest clergy, co-officiants and guest musicians are welcome.

We invite you to take a tour of the Meeting House and schedule a meeting with the Minister and Director of Music to begin planning your wedding ceremony.

Rates include: Rental of the Sanctuary for the rehearsal and ceremony; professional service fees for the Minister and Sexton; and administrative costs. Full payment in advance is required along with a \$300 refundable damage deposit.

- The historic sanctuary has no air conditioning or heating.
- Both halls are wheelchair accessible and equipped with an oval window audio induction loop assistive listening system.
